How to Make Maps by Census Tract for Prevalence, Demographic, Social, and Risk Factor Data

**Step 1:** Open the Interactive Atlas of Heart Disease and Stroke at <a href="https://nccd.cdc.gov/DHDSPAtlas/Default.aspx">https://nccd.cdc.gov/DHDSPAtlas/Default.aspx</a>



Step 2: Click on Select Map Area (located in the upper left corner), then choose your state.
