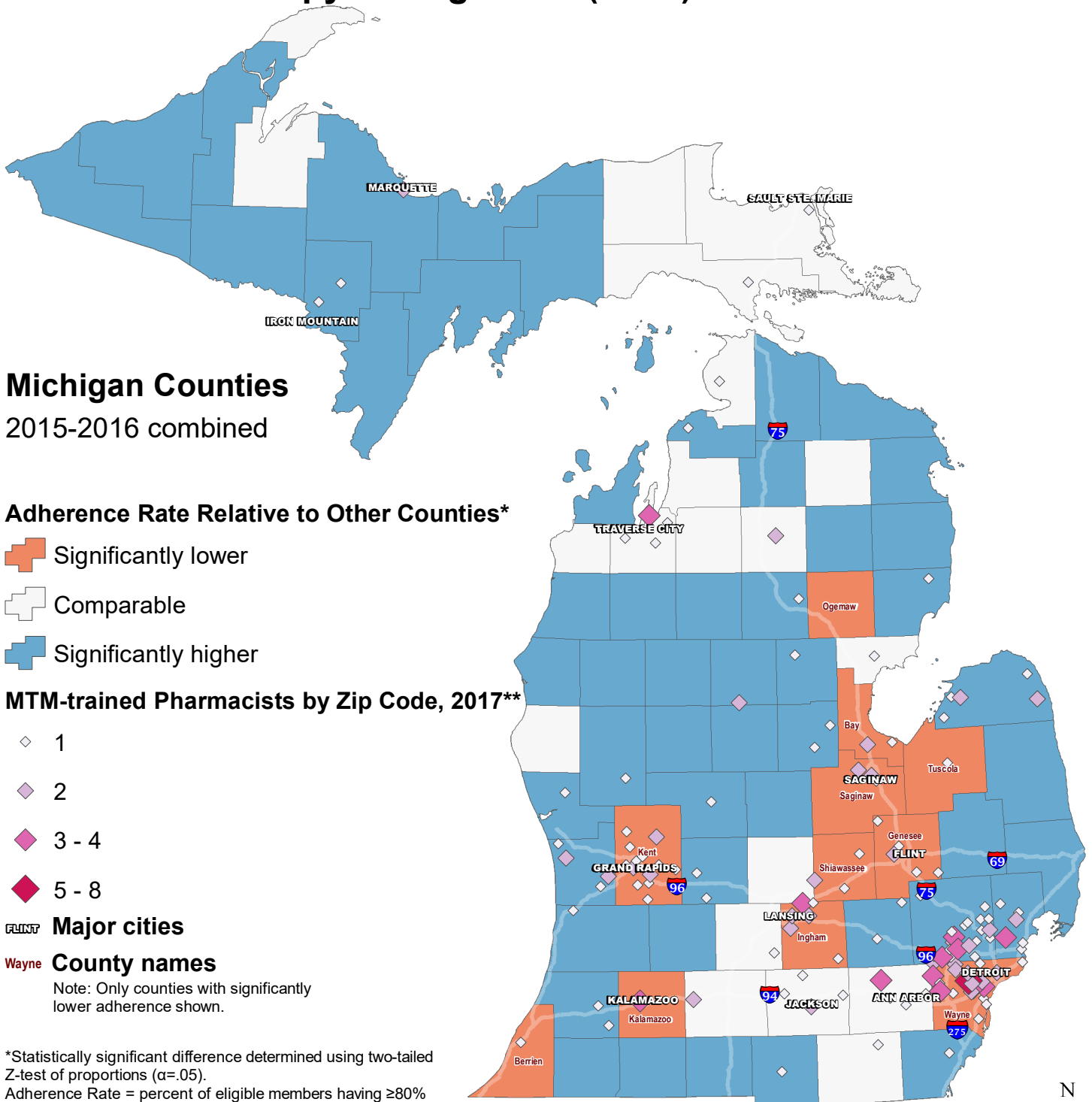


High Blood Pressure (HBP) Medication Adherence Rates and Michigan Pharmacists Association Members (MPA) Trained in Medication Therapy Management (MTM)



*Statistically significant difference determined using two-tailed Z-test of proportions ($\alpha=.05$).
Adherence Rate = percent of eligible members having $\geq 80\%$ of prescription days covered. Calculated using CDC's Proportion of Days Covered (PDC) methodology. Includes members 18-64 years old with 2 or more prescription fills for a high blood pressure medication who are enrolled for 11 or more months of the calendar year.

**MPA represents pharmacists across the state and provides training on MTM services. MTM is an evidence-based approach to identifying and overcoming barriers to medication adherence. Michigan Medicaid approved billing for MTM in 2017. Pharmacist locations are approximate as of May 2018. This map represents only pharmacists who have completed MPA's MTM training in 2017; other training programs are available, including through the American Pharmacists Association.
