If your map may be published, or reprinted, in black and white, be sure to use colors that vary in saturation on the original color map or you run the risk of your symbolization not rendering correctly.





This infamous map, shown to the left, was published by the Wall Street Journal. The map looks great in full color, but when reprinted in black and white the symbolization was lost due to the similar saturation levels of the original colors.
