 - The Download GIS Data tool allows the user to export the displayed dataset to either a shapefile or file geodatabase format as a compressed Zip file. The data can then be used in other mapping software. Prior to launching the tool, create a map by selecting the map area, data and filters in the left navigation bar. [You can also watch the video tutorial 'How to Create a Map'] Once the desired map has been created, move the cursor to the top navigation panel and select the Download GIS Data tool. A new dialog box will appear. Move the cursor to the dialog. Move the cursor to the 'Export Layer Name' field and enter the file name that you will use for the dataset. Next, move the cursor down to the 'Output Format' menu and select 'Shapefile' or 'File Geodatabase'. Move the cursor to the green button and select 'Download Zip File'. A compressed Zip file will be created containing the data displayed in the map with the output format that was selected. This concludes the video tutorial for Download the GIS Data tool.
