

## Toggle 2<sup>nd</sup> Map

- Transcript
  - The Toggle 2<sup>nd</sup> Map tool allows the user to compare 2 maps side by side. This tool can be used to compare 2 health, social, or economic indicators. To use the tool, move the cursor to the top navigation panel and select the View 2<sup>nd</sup> Map tool. Note that the map area is now split into 2 maps. The active map has a blue outline, the inactive map has a black outline. Move the cursor to the left navigation bar. Select a layer to display on the active map. Move the cursor to the first map and select to activate it. Return the cursor to the data selection panel and select a layer to be displayed on the first map. Note that both maps will stay in sync if you zoom in and out or pan around on either map. Move the cursor to the top navigation panel and select Close 2<sup>nd</sup> Map to remove the 2<sup>nd</sup> map from the display area.
