

## **APPLYING CDC'S GUIDELINE FOR PRESCRIBING OPIOIDS: MODULE 8: IMPLEMENTING CDC'S OPIOID PRESCRIBING GUIDELINE INTO CLINICAL PRACTICE WB2862**

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** This module will describe quality improvement (QI) measures intended to help incorporate Guideline recommendations into clinical workflow, outline the five-step QI implementation process, and explain strategies for care coordination that can be deployed at the practice- and system-level of care delivery. This module also offers participants the opportunity to identify strategies, resources, and tools they can use when facilitating the integration of the CDC Guideline into clinical practice.

5. Identify practice-level strategies to improve care coordination
