

# Applying CDC's Guideline for Prescribing Opioids: Module 9: Opioid Use During Pregnancy

**WB2958**

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** The goal of this training is to provide an overview of the opioid use and pregnancy, and to outline recommended practices for before and after child birth. This module will require practitioners to consider the implications of opioid use that are unique to women, and identify risks of opioid use during pregnancy. This activity will also give practitioners the opportunity to learn about best practices for prenatal care when opioids are being used, as well as best practices for postpartum care of mother and child in cases of opioid use disorder (OUD).

- 1) Recognize that opioid use by women presents unique considerations

- 4) Describe best practices concerning opioid use during prenatal care
- 5) Describe best practices concerning opioid use during postpartum care of mother and child
