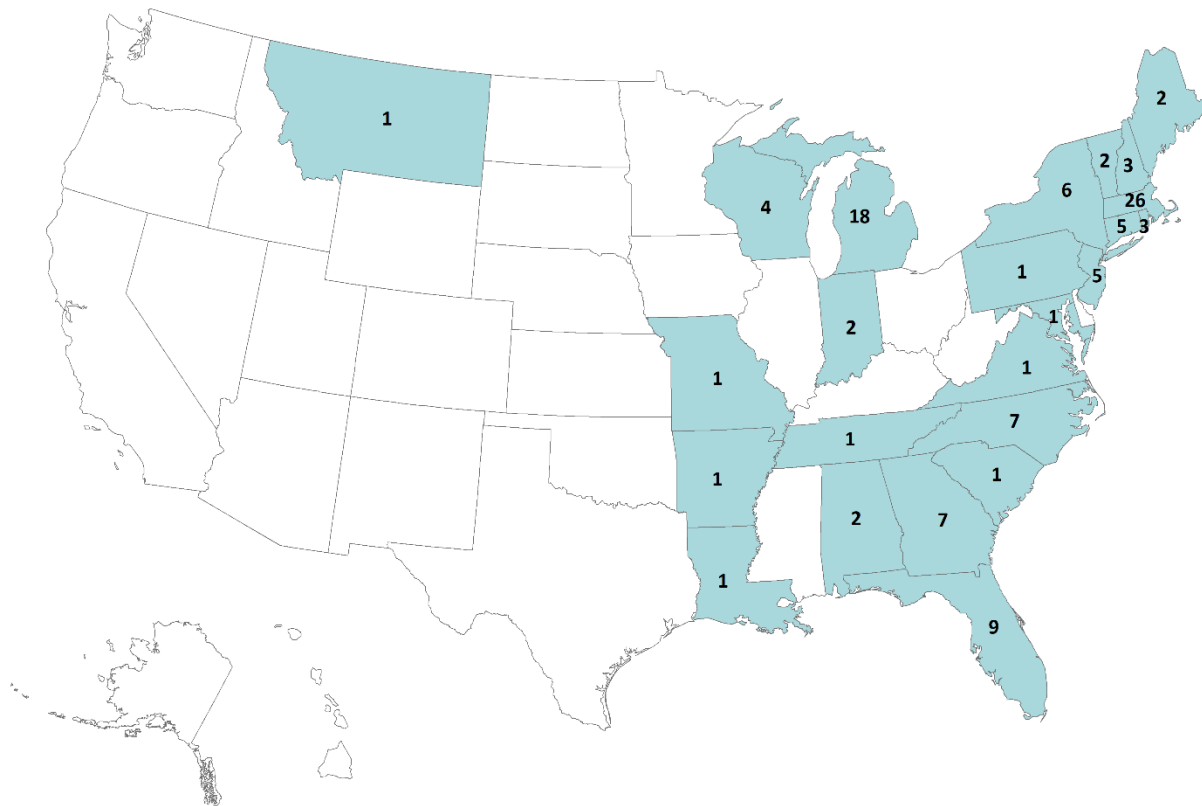


Eastern equine encephalitis virus neuroinvasive disease cases reported by state of residence, 2011–2020
