The scope of this award will enhance the implementation of peer education and outreach through Modeling and Reinforcement to Combat HIV/AIDS (MARCH) Program in the Federal Police setting, expand the implementation of Behavior Change Communication (BCC) interventions within the HIV/AIDS workplace program, and increase support to the National HIV/AIDS Program in the design and implementation of capacity-building efforts to strengthen the quality and effectiveness of HIV/AIDS service delivery.
Single Source Justification Criteria Cited	The Federal Police is the only organization with a mandate to work within the Federal Police structure. It is a national institution engaged in security and peace of the country. Because of security reasons no other organization will be allowed to operate fully in some of the Federal Police campuses. The Federal Police is capable of managing the program because it has its own hospitals in Addis Ababa and other regional cities. Its health care workers are employed at the different health facilities and at the prisons Also the Federal Police has successfully managed CDC supported programs in the past and has experience in establishing a Health Service Directorate, with HIV/AIDS Prevention, Care and Treatment and Support Offices.
