Single Source Justification Criteria Cited	The Ghana AIDS Commission is a supra-ministerial public service body established on January 16, 2002, under Act 613 of the 1992 Ghana constitution under the Chairmanship of the President of the Republic of Ghana. As the governmental coordinating body for all HIV/AIDS activities in Ghana, the Ghana AIDS Commission (GAC) has been the national lead for the ongoing collection and dissemination of data related to HIV and AIDS. By establishing a single eligibility cooperative agreement with GAC, CDC is seeking to strengthen GAC's role as the coordinating body for all HIV/AIDS efforts in Ghana by providing resources <u>directly</u> to GAC for activities that are inherently the job of GAC, such as coordination of key meetings, training key national M & E staff, establishing action plans and key strategic policies, supervision of national M & E staff, etc.
