Purpose of the Award	The purpose of this funding announcement is to support the Government of Botswana’s response to the HIV/AIDS pandemic so as to reduce new HIV infections, strengthen health and strategic information systems, build human resource and infrastructure capacity and extend access to quality HIV/AIDS services in a sustainable manner in the Republic of Botswana. Emphasis will be on prevention, policy strengthening, capacity building and improving metrics for evidence based planning. All program activities proposed in this funding announcement are part of the Botswana Partnership Framework and the National Strategic Framework.
Single Source Justification Criteria Cited	This funding announcement seeks to coordinate government to government collaboration in keeping with PEPFAR’s vision for sustainable country ownership of programs. Only the GOB has the authority to harness and deploy the existing health investments at the national, district and community level for the purposes of responding to emerging health challenges including HIV/AIDS. The GOB managed PEPFAR funds during Phase I of PEPFAR through a cooperative agreement with the Centers for Disease Control. The GOB through its various implementing bodies is the sole government entity authorized by law to protect and preserve the right to health for its citizens. All donor funding in Botswana is channeled to the Ministry of Finance, Development and Planning (MFDP).
