Purpose of the Award	The purpose of this announcement is to enhance the capacity of the Government of Suriname to fully implement its national goal to scale-up and strengthen HIV prevention, strategic information, laboratory, and related support activities. Since the Ministry of Health is mandated to coordinate the health-sector response to the HIV epidemic in Suriname, this announcement allows for the expansion of HIV/AIDS activities in Suriname in partnership with Ministry of Health.
Single Source Justification Reasons Cited	<p>The Suriname Ministry of Health is the only organization in Suriname with the legal authority and mandate to provide technical support and coordination to national health organizations as outlined in the cooperative agreement. This includes the legal authority to collect and collate crucial HIV/AIDS data, as well as other health information.</p> <p>The purpose of this announcement is to build upon an existing framework of strategic information activities, HIV Prevention interventions, laboratory activities, and program development activities for the Ministry of Health. The proposed cooperative agreement will support ongoing collaborative activities between the Ministry of Health and CDC staff, and will expand initiatives to strengthen Suriname’s national response to HIV and AIDS.</p>
