Purpose of the Award	<p>The purpose of this program is to enhance the capacity of the Ugandan Ministry of Health to fully implement its national goal of strengthening health system including scale up HIV prevention, care, and treatment and other priority health conditions.</p> <p>This funding opportunity will provide continued financial support to the Ministry of Health of Uganda to achieve the objectives outlined in the nation's Health Sector Strategic and Investment Plan 2010 aimed at expanding efforts to improve access to quality HIV prevention, care, and treatment to HIV infected/affected persons and their families. Funding resources made available through this mechanism will underwrite the following: 1) the development, revision, and updating of national policies and technical guidelines relevant to all HIV program initiatives, with a focus on the integration of these and evidence based prevention into care and treatment and other health program; 2) strengthening the national laboratory services by supporting implementation of the, Ugandan National Health Laboratory Policy (2009) through the National Health Laboratory Strategic Plan 2010 - 2015; and, 3) ensure technical support for strategic-information activities, including the implementation of revised Health Management Information system tools, implementation of revised national protocols integrated disease surveillance including HIV/TB surveillance, conducting evaluation of health sector program activities in relation to HIV/TB co-infection and other health priority concerns.</p>
Single Source Justification Reasons Cited	<p>The Uganda Ministry of Health (MOH) was created by the Uganda Central Government to provide both technical oversight for all government and private health providers, as well as, policy development and guidance for all health issues for the Government of Uganda. The MOH is the only government entity mandated by an act of parliament to develop policy, provide policy implementation guidelines and monitor the implementation of National Health Programs. No other organization or entity has the authority to carry out these activities. The MOH is mandated to oversee the implementation of the Health Sector Strategic and Investment Plan, which was developed to address the health requirements in Uganda's National Development Plan. Within the MOH there are key departments that have developed key programs and oversight that address specific areas of interest including: AIDS Control Program, Malaria Control Program, Nutrition Division, Division of Reproductive Health and the Resource Centre.
