Purpose of the Award	The purpose of this program is to strengthen the capacity of the Federal HIV/AIDS Prevention and Control Office of Ethiopia (FHAPCO) to coordinate, monitor and evaluate the multi-sectoral HIV/AIDS response in Ethiopia. This FOA will support improved FHAPCO coordination with Regional HAPCOs and Regional Health Bureaus (RHBs) as well as key implementing partners. National information systems will be strengthened, as well as FHAPCO and regional capacities for monitoring and evaluation of health facilities, activities and outcomes including those related to HIV/AIDS prevention, control and care and treatment activities. Through this FOA, FHAPCO will coordination with other national agencies and entities for building monitoring and evaluation capacities.
Single Source Justification Reasons Cited	<p>The Federal HAPCO is the arm of the Ethiopian Ministry of Health with the authority and mandate to coordinate the national multi-sectoral HIV/AIDS response, monitor and evaluate ongoing HIV/AIDS prevention, care, treatment and support programs, as well as coordinate resource mobilization for the national response.</p> <p>This FOA, provides support to FHAPCO to manage and coordinate the multi-sectoral approach to the national HIV/AIDS program. This includes coordination between the Federal Ministry of Health’s HIV/AIDS Prevention and Control Office (HAPCO), Regional HAPCOs and Health Bureaus in eleven regions and a larger number of donor agencies and implementing partners. The federal administration must also ensure the coordination by regional authorities of activities being conducted at the lower administrative levels. Additionally, it is the responsibility of the federal administration to monitor and evaluation the effectiveness of HIV/AIDS prevention, control, care, and treatment activities being conducted throughout the country.</p> <p>The Federal HAPCO is currently receiving CDC support under CDC’s CoAg with the Ministry of Health (PS09-9104). However, discussions between CDC-Ethiopia and Government of Ethiopia have recommended establishment of a separate CoAg for FHAPCO with activities more specifically related to the Federal HAPCO mandate.</p>
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
