Purpose of the Award	The purpose of this funding opportunity announcement is to build capacity within the health system of the Government of Vietnam (GVN). The overarching goal is to build and expand institutional capacity within the GVN to coordinate and implement evaluations, research, operations and management of HIV/AIDS and other public health programs and to effectively respond to health system strengthening needs, as identified by GVN and other stakeholders.
Single Source Justification Reasons Cited	In 1902 the Indochina Medico-Pharmaceutical University, the first university in the former territory of Indochina was established in Hanoi. In 1975, the organization’s name was officially changed to Hanoi Medical University (HMU) with a mandate from the Vietnam Ministry of Health (MOH) as Vietnam’s only health workforce training and research institution in the health sector. HMU is the only institution capable of fulfilling the purpose of this FOA due to its unique position as the sole institution in Vietnam that leads a national network of medical universities, colleges and secondary medical schools and its robust history of capacity-building, program evaluation and research.
