Purpose of the Award	The purpose of this program is to strengthen the capacity of the Government of the Republic of Zambia (GRZ) in the area of statistical analysis by establishing an agreement with the

	<p>Zambia Central Statistical Office so that it may be able to provide statistical support to other Government institutions implementing HIV/AIDS programs. The program further aims at providing support to the implementation of all HIV/AIDS surveys such as the AIDS Indicator Survey, the Demographic and Health Survey and other HIV/AIDS that the Government of Zambia would like to implement in order to assess its national HIV/AIDS response. It also aims to support the alignment and integration of information systems and establishment of a national data repository from which quality data may be used for decision-making.</p> <p>The national population-based surveys are the only means through which the GRZ is informed about the prevalence and incidence of HIV and other health outcomes in the general population. The programmatic objectives are to collect information on the unmet need for treatment and monitor the trends over time, estimate the HIV prevalence and incidence, and produce child and maternal indicators. Other objectives include the provision of statistical training to other Government departments that have been charged with monitoring the national HIV/AIDS response in order to ensure adequate capacity is developed at the local level.</p>
<p>Single Source Justification Reasons Cited</p>	<p>This funding opportunity is limited to the Zambia Central Statistical Office (CSO) because it's the only institution mandated by the Government of the Republic of Zambia (GRZ) to provide comprehensive, national-level, statistical information to institutions of the Government, private sector and the wider national and international community.</p> <p>The CSO has the responsibility of promoting increased utilization of statistical information for effective decision making and informed debate on the economy by all major stakeholders. The CSO is a Government Department under the Ministry of Finance and National Planning (MFNP). The CSO is responsible for coordinating all statistical activities in the country and is a major source of official statistics. The CSO is currently implementing a population-based survey with biological specimens that will be tested for HIV and Syphilis with funding from CDC. It has also previously received CDC funding for the implementation of a pilot sample vital registration with verbal autopsy (SAVVY) system. The new project emphasizes support to population-based surveys which the CSO is currently implementing with funding from CDC.</p>
