Funding Opportunity Announcement CDC-RFA-GH16-1632

Supporting Implementation of HIV and TB Services for Epidemic Control in the Republic of Mozambique under the President’s Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR)

	Question	Response
1.	CDC has defined high priority districts with distinct activities. The FOA only mentions few districts, which is not an exhaustive list of the CDC identified priority districts. Would CDC please clarify the districts that are targeted as part of this FOA?	The FOA lists the districts that all applicants should be applying for. These are the only districts that the applicants should be applying for when submitting their application.
2.	Can CDC please confirm that the most affected districts, based on volume and HIV prevalence, should still be proposed for activities, even if not named in this FOA?	No, if the district is not included in the FOA then it should not be included in the application.
3.	Would CDC please confirm that the total funding ceiling for activities in all of the listed provinces in this FOA is \$80 million for year one?	The Year One Award Ceiling is \$80,000,000. This covers all requirements of the FOA.
4.	Can CDC please clarify intended funding levels for each of the listed provinces for year one?	The scope of the application is ultimately at the discretion of the applicant. Applicant proposals will be assessed against all of the requirements of the FOA using the Review Criteria listed in the FOA. Applicants should submit a budget taking into account the award ceiling of the FOA.
5.	Would CDC please share its intentions for directing activities by programmatic area, and their respective anticipated funding?	The scope of the application is ultimately at the discretion of the applicant. Applicant proposals will be assessed against all of the requirements of the FOA using the Review Criteria listed in the FOA. Applicants should submit a budget taking into account the award ceiling of the FOA.
