

Q&A for GH14-1413, *Local Nongovernmental Partnerships for Sustained Country Leadership in Zimbabwe under the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR)*

- Q1. Activities on pg. 9: Can applicants add or amend the stated activities, output, and outcome by objectives?
- A1. All applications will be judged by the objective review panel according to their responsiveness to the activities, outputs, outcomes, objectives and other guidance included in the FOA text.
- Q2. Consortium application submissions: Does the prime have to meet all the eligibility requirements for the funding preference points or can it be a combination with the Sub-awardees?
- A2. The funding preference requirement holds to the prime organization only. The prime organization must demonstrate how they meet the funding preference criteria. It would not be sufficient for it to be met by the sub-awardee.
- Q3. Consortium Submissions: Do the prime as well as the sub-awardees all need to have DUNS numbers?
- A3. Guidance on sub-awardee DUNS number requirements is included in the FOA text. Section 3, under Registration Information, states: "If funds are awarded to an applicant organization that includes sub-awardees, sub-awardees must provide their DUNS numbers prior to accepting any sub-awards."
- Q4. What is the deadline for questions to CDC on this FOA?
- A4. As stated in Section VIII of the FOA, all questions must be submitted no later than 15 days after FOA publication. This FOA was published on grants.gov on May 14, therefore, the deadline for Q&A was May 29, 2014.
