


THE GLOBAL CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE (CVD) CRISIS

Cardiovascular disease is the world's biggest killer, claiming **17.5 million** lives per year 1/3 prematurely under 70 years.

This number is steadily increasing



80% of all CVD deaths are from **heart attacks** and **strokes**

 **75%** occur in **developing countries**

Premature deaths from heart attacks and strokes threaten global health and development.
