


MEASLES AND RUBELLA MOVE FAST



Failure to vaccinate children against measles & rubella puts them at risk of severe health complications, such as




Rubella is generally a mild illness but when pregnant women become infected, there is a **90%** chance of the fetus having **congenital rubella syndrome (CRS)**. The baby can be born with multiple birth defects – if it survives at all.

Rubella vaccination prevents mothers from giving birth to babies with **CRS** and prevents life-long disability.

100,000 babies are born with **CRS** around the world each year.

More than **60%** of the **21.5 million** children who did **not** receive one dose of **measles** vaccine in 2013 came from only 6 countries

India: 6.4M | Nigeria: 2.7M | Pakistan: 1.7M | Ethiopia: 1.1M | Indonesia: 0.7M | DR Congo: 0.7M



Measles is a leading cause of death among children around the world.

400 die every day, 16 every hour – despite the fact that a safe and effective vaccine has been available for over 50 years.
