


# CANCER


## WORLDWIDE

At least 22% of the most common cancers can be prevented by not smoking.



70% of cervical cancer cases can be prevented with currently available HPV vaccines.

Only 5% of global cancer resources are spent in less-developed countries.



Liver and lung cancer remain lethal in all nations:  
5-year survival is below  
20% in Europe,  
15-19% in North America,  
7-9% in Mongolia and Thailand.
