At least 3 years of Global Public Health experience

You must confirm you will attend no later than January 29, 2010.

Do not make travel reservations until your registration has been accepted and you receive your invitation to attend. Registration is limited to the first 50 qualified candidates.

Positions are overseas

Non-US Citizens can be hired for overseas positions only as third-country nationals[⊗] (example: you are not eligible to work in Burkino Faso if you are a citizen of Burkino Faso. You would be eligible for positions in other countries.)

Rules and regulations: Complete registration must be received by January 15, 2010. You will be notified by January 22, 2010 via e-mail whether or not your registration has been accepted. For Health Scientist series: Degree/major study in an academic field related to the health sciences or allied sciences appropriate to the work of the position.

For Medical Officer series: Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Osteopathy from a school in the United States or Canada approved by a recognized accrediting body in the year of the applicant's graduation. (A Doctor of Medicine or equivalent degree from a foreign medical school that provided education and

[⊗] A third-country national (TCN) is an individual who is neither a citizen of the United States nor of the country to which assigned for duty. United States citizens, U.S. permanent residents, and third country nationals are eligible for the Title 42 Fellowship positions.

medical knowledge substantially equivalent to accredited schools in the United States may be demonstrated by permanent certification by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates [ECFMG] or a fifth pathway certificate for Americans who completed premedical education in the United States and graduate education in a foreign country.]

Foreign education / transcripts must be credentialed

Submit official transcripts for highest degree earned that qualify the applicant for the position. Any foreign transcripts must be translated and certified through a credentials evaluation company at least 4 weeks before the effective date of the appointment. The cost associated for credentials evaluation is the responsibility of the selectee.

Informal interviews will be conducted at the event. Come prepared to interview and with multiple hard copies of your resume.

To be considered to attend the event, submit your complete registration form and full resume by JANUARY 15TH to GVL5@CDC.GOV .
