# **Use of Enhanced Barrier Precautions (EBP)**

**Use EBP for** residents with indwelling medical devices, wounds, or those who are colonized by or infected with a multidrug-resistant organism (MDRO).

#### **Use EBP when:**

- · Dressing or bathing
- Transferring
- Changing linens
- Assisting with toileting
- Accessing indwelling medical devices
- · Providing wound care
- Other high-contact resident care activities

### **Key Steps:**

Before entering a resident's room with an EBP sign:

- Gather all needed supplies & materials
- 2. Clean hands
- Correctly put on a gown and gloves
- **4.** After care, throw away gown and gloves
- 5. Clean hands again

Finish all steps before moving on to another resident.









## To assemble pocket guide:

- 1. Print landscape on 8.5x11 paper.
- 2. Cut along the dashed line.
- **3.** Fold in half vertically (top to bottom).
- 4. Fold in half horizontally (left to right).
