




Trends in Sexual Activity among US Teens, YRBS, 1991-2013



National Youth Risk Behavior Surveys, 1991-2013


Trends in Sexual Risk Behaviors among US Teens, YRBS, 1991-2013

*Among the students nationwide who were currently sexually active.

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

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













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
Percent of US Secondary Schools Which Required and Taught...



6. Importance of using a condom at the same time as another form of contraception to prevent both STDs and pregnancy
7. How to obtain condoms
8. How to correctly use a condom


16 Critical Sex Ed Topics

16. Preventive care that is necessary to maintain reproductive and sexual health











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


Middle Schools: Teach importance of Using Condoms Consistently and Correctly



Summary

- Sexual health education
 - Does not reliably cover a broad enough range of topics
 - Does not start early enough
 - Is declining over time across the country
- Inclusiveness for LGBTQ students is getting better
 - Professional development for teachers
 - Relevant content in sex ed curricula
 - Gay-straight alliances or similar clubs
