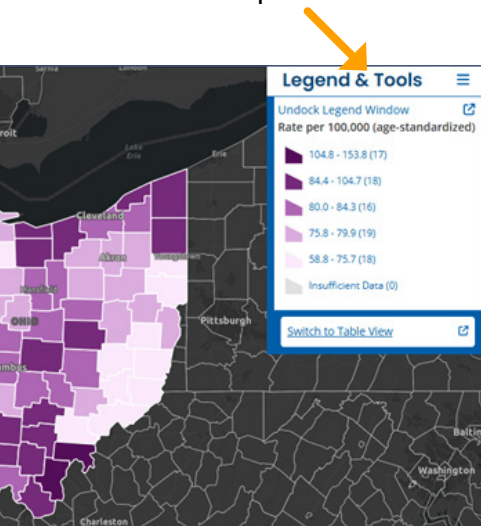


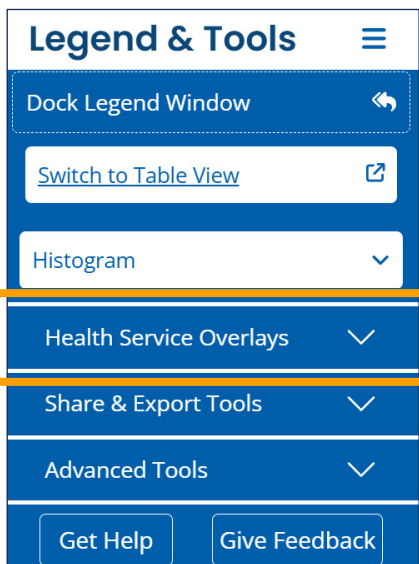
How to Add Proximity to Care to a State Map of Local-Level Data

Step 1 To get started, follow the instructions for making a state map of local-level data using [CDC's Atlas of Heart Disease and Stroke](#)

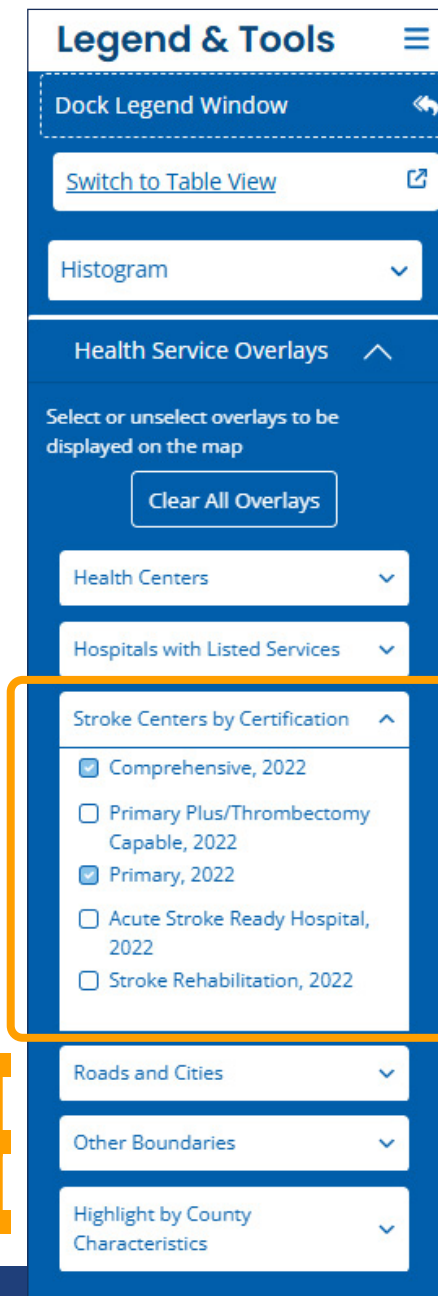
Step 2 To *display proximity to care* on the map created in Step 1, go to the **Legend & Tools** menu at the top right corner of the map. Click on the three bars to release the dropdown menu.



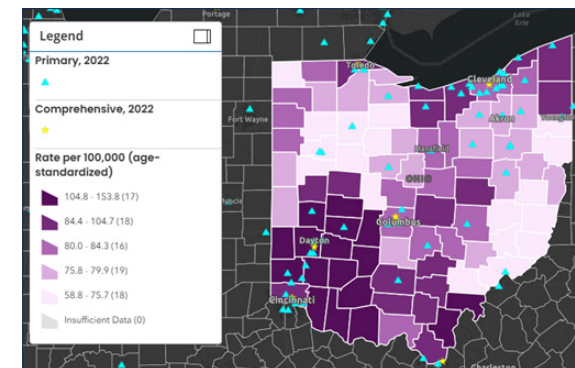
Step 3 Select **Health Service Overlays**. Then choose the type of health care facility you would like to add (e.g., select Stroke Centers by Certification, then Comprehensive, Primary).



You can also display the main transportation routes, major cities, and additional geographical boundaries on your map by selecting those elements in the dropdown menu.



Step 4 The map with your selections will be displayed.
