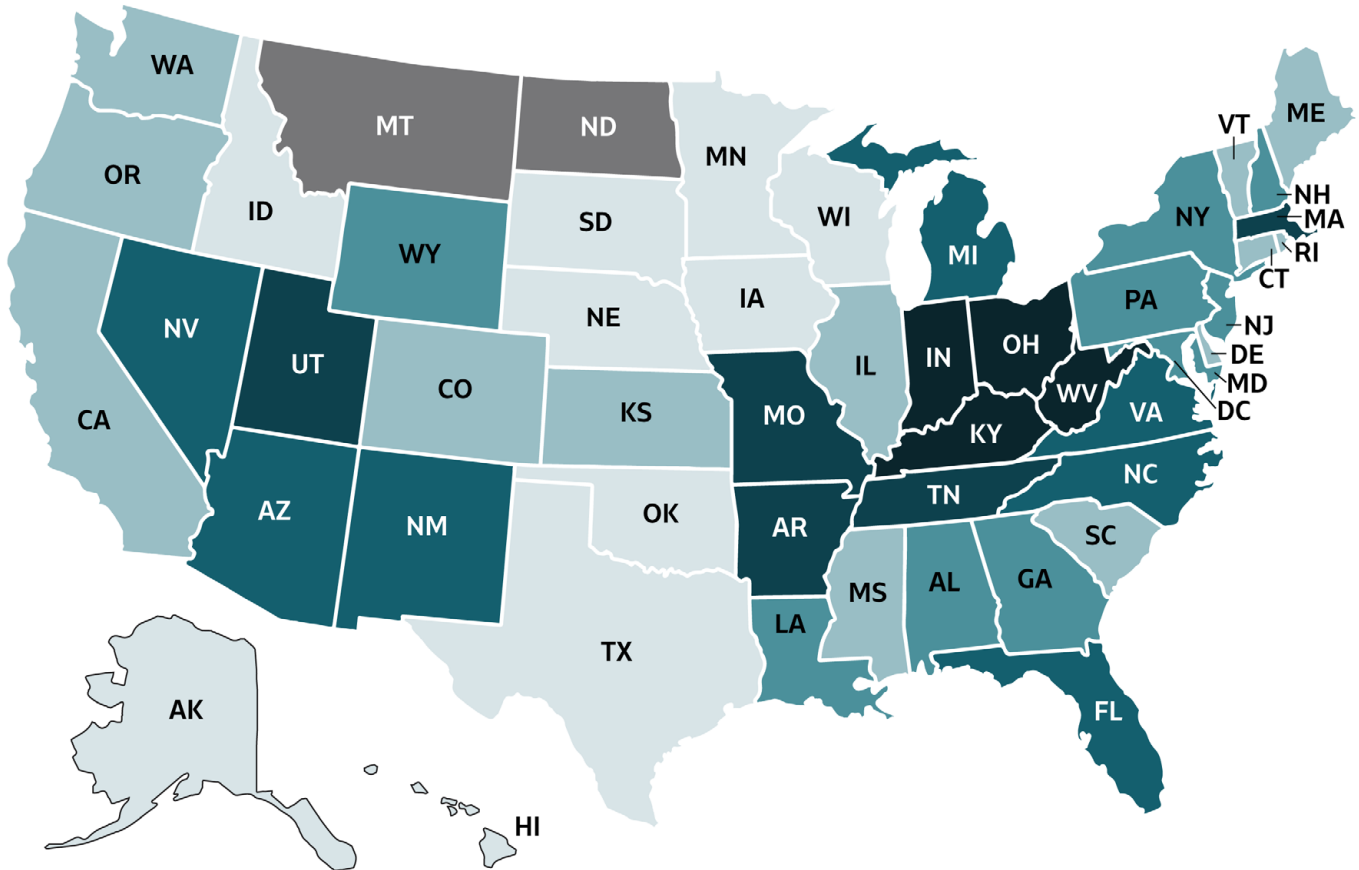









**Figure 1.3. Rates of reported hepatitis A, by state or jurisdiction — United States, 2018**
