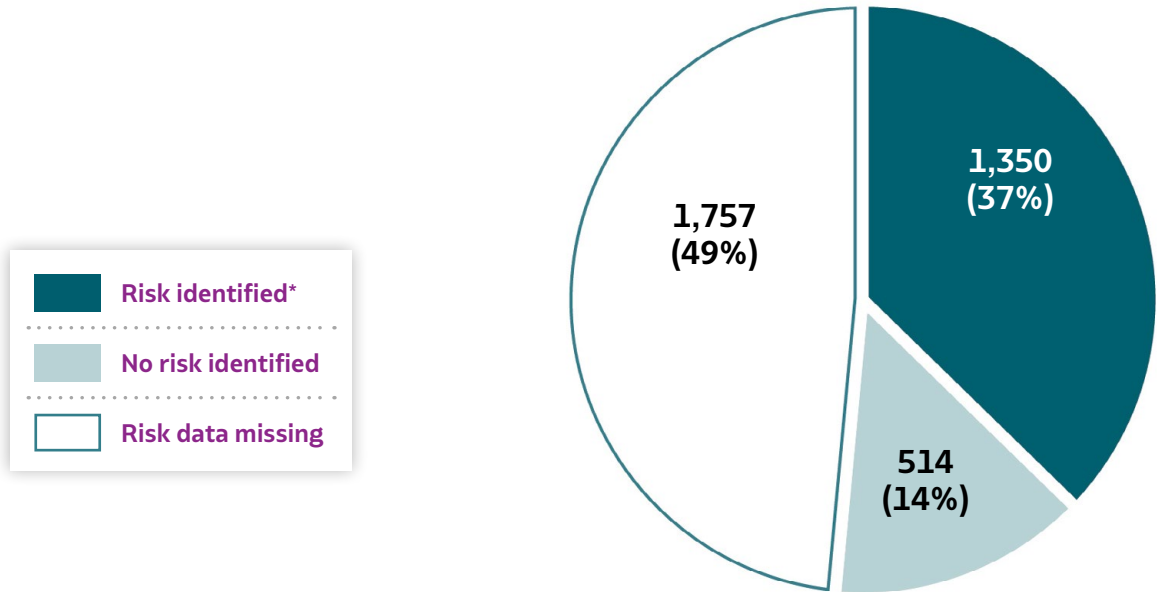


Figure 3.7. Availability of information on risk behaviors/exposures* associated with reported cases of acute hepatitis C – United States, 2018
