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- Part II: Section A. Funding Opportunity Description, 2. CDC Project Description: Clarification on the program activities required for the funding opportunity announcement. The words “component(s)” was replaced with “program strategies”. (page 2, 7, 10, 18, 23, 25, 27, 37)
- Part II: Section A. Funding Opportunity Description, 2. CDC Project Description: Clarification on the program activities required for the funding opportunity announcement. The words “components” was replaced with “strategies and activities”. (page 7)
- Part II: Section A. Funding Opportunity Description, 2. CDC Project Description: Clarification on the program activities required for the funding opportunity announcement. The words “component” was replaced with “program”. (page 12, 14, 15, 20)
- Part II: Section A. Funding Opportunity Description. iii. Strategies and Activities. Removed language requiring the submission of a service agreement with a clinical care provider. This service agreement is not required with the application submission. Revised text - “If applicant organizations are not considered clinics that primarily serve the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, and Transgender (LGBT) community and do not have the existing capacity to perform integrated screening tests, a service agreement with a clinical care provider in the service area(s) must be established.” (page 13)
- Part II: Section A: Funding Opportunity Description, i. CDC Evaluation and Performance Measurement Strategy: The indicator for Comprehensive HIV Prevention with High-Risk HIV-Negative Persons was corrected. Revised text – “Indicator: Percentage of HIV-negative YMSM of color and YTG persons of color who are referred to a PrEP provider within 30 days for clinical evaluation. Indicator: Percentage of HIV-negative YMSM of color and YTG persons of color who are referred to a nPEP provider for clinical evaluation.” (page 24)
- Part II: Section A: Funding Opportunity Description, c. Organizational Capacity of Awardees to Implement the Approach: Safe Space was moved from *Organizational Capacity of Awardees to Implement the Approach* to *Implement to Program Promotion, Outreach, and Recruitment* section. The use of a safe space remains as a required activity associated with the FOA. (page 25)
- Part II: Section C. Eligibility Information, 2. Additional Information on Eligibility: Clarification on required 501(c)(3) eligibility. The following sentence was added, “Organizations with non-profit 501 (c)(3) IRS status that are affiliated with and/or under the administrative and management authority of a college or university are not eligible to apply.” (page 29)
- Part II: Section C. Eligibility Information, 10. Project Narrative: Clarification on maximum page limit for project narrative. The following sentence was added, “Applicants may apply for one funding category only; therefore, this is a single component FOA.” (page 35)

- Part II: Section D. Required Registrations, 12. Budget Narrative: Deleted “a. Referral to Primary Medical Care”. This is not a required program activity under Comprehensive HIV Prevention with High-Risk HIV Negative Persons. (page 38)
- Part II: Section E. Review and Selection Process, 1. Review and Selection Process: Applications will be reviewed in three phases. b. Phase II Review: Attachment I: Sample Table of Contents was labeled incorrectly. The attachment letter was changed to the correct label. (page 44)
