**Summary Proceedings**

The twenty-seventh meeting of the National Center for Injury Prevention and Control (NCIPC) Board of Scientific Counselors (BSC) was convened on Tuesday, August 14, 2018 via teleconference and Adobe Connect. The BSC met in closed session in accordance with the Privacy Act and the Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA). Dr. Arlene Greenspan, Designated Federal Official served as chair.

This meeting was closed to the public in accordance with the determination that it was concerned with matters exempt from mandatory disclosure under Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6), title 5, U.S. Code and Section 10(d) of the Federal Advisory committee Act, as amended (5 U.S.C. Appendix 2). The Scientific Review Officer explained policies and procedures regarding avoidance of conflict of interest situations; voting and priority rating; and confidentiality of application materials, committee discussions, and recommendations.
