

WISQARS Data Visualization Treemap Training: Narrative/Audio Description

Descriptive Text:	CDC Logo. CDC Logo zooms out.
Text on Screen:	Welcome to WISQARS Data Visualization. This tool displays fatal and nonfatal injury data in an interactive, visual format.
Descriptive Text:	Music playing in the background. Animated text and video. Logo for WISQARS. Image of computer Appears.
Text on Screen:	This tutorial will focus on a useful feature: The Tree Map. The Tree Map lets you see and compare causes of injury data.
Descriptive Text:	Orange Box Appears around Tree Map
Text on Screen:	For example, you can use the Tree Map to identify causes of injury death and understand how they are distributed by Intent and Mechanism of death. The Tree Map can filter and display statistics by Intent and Mechanism of Death.
Text on Screen:	Hovering over a specific intent of death will display more information with the number and percentages of deaths.
Descriptive Text:	Orange Box appears around Suicide Intent of Death, Unintentional Intent and Homicide Intent.
Text on Screen:	By selecting a specific Intent of Death, the Tree Map can refresh to display the Mechanisms of Death within the selected Intent. Let's take a look at Suicide. Select the green Suicide box to the right.
Descriptive Text:	New Tree Map Appears.
Text on Screen:	This displays the different mechanisms of death within the suicide data. You can quickly identify

each mechanism along with the number and percentage of deaths.

Descriptive Text:

Orange box around Suffocation, Drug Poisoning, Drowning, and Cut/Pierce Mechanism of Death.
