CDC's Standardization Programs provide laboratories an opportunity to standardize steroid hormone, lipid, and lipoprotein measurements to CDC's reference measurement procedures. The CDC Standardization Programs offers services in two categories:

(1) Laboratory Standardization Programs

Standardization services are provided to ensure measurement accuracy by programs that assist manufacturers of in-vitro diagnostic (IVD) assays to minimize calibration bias. These programs also assess performance of laboratory analytical systems.

(2) Reference measurement services

The CDC Hormone and Lipid Standardization Programs are providing measurement services to assign values to serum and other materials used for calibration and calibration verification, and to help laboratories using lab developed tests and assay manufacturers with technical questions that help improve their assay performance
