

The LMBP A-6 Cycle: Review and Evaluation Methods for Quality Improvement

DESCRIPTION

Effectively identifying and recommending laboratory medicine best practices for quality improvement projects demands an evidenced-based, transparent review process. This course, The LMBP A-6 Cycle: Review and Evaluation Methods for Quality Improvement, introduces the Laboratory Medicine Best Practice (LMBP) A-6 method for conducting systematic evidence reviews.

The LMBP initiative aims to:

- Develop and apply transparent evidence-based methods for reviewing interdisciplinary quality improvement practices
- Conduct systematic reviews to assess the effectiveness of quality improvement practices on patient outcomes



- Provide a central source of information on the comparative effectiveness of laboratory medicine practices
- Facilitate a network for the exchange of information on effective laboratory practices

AUDIENCE

This basic level course is intended for those conducting and/or overseeing systematic reviews for research practices including laboratory directors, supervisors and technologists, quality managers, pathologists, research and industry scientists, students, and Systematic Review Coordinators. Laboratories that routinely conduct Quality Improvement (QI) projects, outside of systematic reviews, can also benefit from this course.
