


California Serogroup Virus Neuroinvasive Disease* Cases Reported by Year, 1964-2010



* Neuroinvasive disease includes cases reported as encephalitis, meningoencephalitis, or meningitis. Most reported cases of California serogroup virus neuroinvasive disease are due to La Crosse encephalitis virus.

Data Table: In the United States, approximately 80-100 La Crosse encephalitis virus (LACV) neuroinvasive disease cases are reported annually. This graph demonstrates how the number of cases can vary markedly from year to year.
