

Biomechanics and Their Severity (R01). She requested that anyone having conflicts of interest with any of these applicant organizations, or with the principal investigators or key participants indicated on the lists provided to them prior to the call, so state their conflict. This same procedure was followed before each vote.

**Dr. Hawkins** began the voting process for the nine panels shown in Appendix A. All reports were unanimously accepted by formal motion and vote with two exceptions that were deferred. There was not a quorum to vote on the panel for CE008003, "Preventing Violence and Violence Related Injury" and there was no vote on the panel for CE08001, "Youth Violence Prevention through Community Level Change" due to some confusion regarding the number of nonresponsive applications. These two panels will be voted upon at the next IRG meeting.




