

## Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale – Revised (WAIS-R)

### **Description**

The Abbreviated Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale estimates IQ. The abbreviated index uses four subtests (arithmetic, block design, picture completion, and information) and provides robust estimates of verbal and performance IQ that are highly correlated with the full WAIS assessments [Reynolds et al, 1983].

Refer to the data codebook for the detailed information of each variable.

### **Study Sample**

46 participants in the study completed this test.

### **Data Collection Method**

It was administered by trained psychiatric interviewer in paper-and-pencil format at the time when the participant finished CANTAB on day 1.
