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US Department of Health and Human Services Dr. Christopher M. Jones serves as senior advisor in the Office of Public Health Strategy and Analysis in the Office of the Commissioner at FDA. In this role, he works on a variety of priority public health policy and research issues facing FDA. At FDA, Chris maintains an active research portfolio on drug abuse and overdose. Prior to joining FDA, he was a lead subject matter expert on drug overdose at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). His CDC work focused on strategic policy development and implementation, engaging national and state partners, and conducting research to improve policy and clinical practice. Prior to CDC, he completed a one year detail to the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy as Senior Public Health Advisor. During this detail, he co-led the development of the Administration's Prescription Drug Abuse Prevention Plan released in April 2011.
