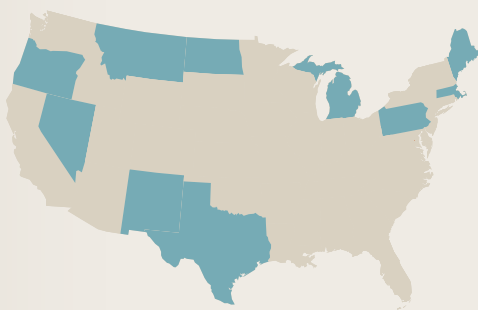
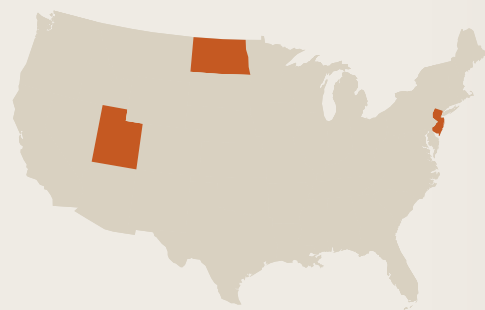


STATE LAWS & E-CIGARETTES

ONLY 3 STATES **PROHIBIT INDOOR E-CIGARETTE USE** IN PRIVATE WORKPLACES, RESTAURANTS, AND BARS



Over 300 million Americans, including 70 million children, live in states where they could be exposed to either secondhand smoke or e-cigarette aerosol in worksites, restaurants, and bars.



E-CIGARETTE AEROSOL IS NOT HARMLESS WATER VAPOR, IT CAN CONTAIN NICOTINE AND OTHER TOXINS.
