Cria Perrine, PhD, is a Lieutenant Commander in the U.S. Public Health Service and an epidemiologist in CDC's Nutrition Branch within the Division of Nutrition, Physical Activity, and Obesity. For the last five years she has been the lead epidemiologist for CDC's Maternity Practices in Infant Nutrition and Care (mPINC) survey, conducting analyses to produce individualized hospital reports, state reports, and web tables on U.S. hospital practices that support breastfeeding. Dr. Perrine originally joined CDC as an Epidemic Intelligence Service Officer assigned to the International Micronutrient Team in the Nutrition Branch. She received a PhD in Nutrition and Health Sciences from Emory University and has authored more than 50 publications related to nutrition and maternal and child health.
