CDC estimates that vaccination of children born between 1994 and 2013 will:

prevent **322 million** illnesses

→ 
more than the current population of the entire U.S.A.

help avoid **732,000** deaths

→ 
greater than the population of Boston, MA.

save nearly **\$1.4 trillion** in total societal costs
(that includes \$295 billion in direct costs)

→ 
or \$4,473 for each American
