

## **AUTISM CASE TRAINING: MANAGING**

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:** Modules are designed to increase knowledge and change competency of early intervention and education, treatments for autism spectrum disorder, and anticipatory guidance concerning autism spectrum disorder. Content was developed by developmental-behavioral pediatricians.

4. Identify specific causes that can increase maladaptive behavior
5. Describe the components of a functional behavioral analysis
6. Discuss the evidence-based indications for the initiation of pharmacotherapy in children with ASD
7. List the classes of drugs used to treat children with ASD
8. Describe the most common complementary and alternative medicine (CAM) therapies used to treat children with ASD
9. Describe some of the common developmental issues that present in children with ASD and how to evaluate them
10. Identify management approaches and strategies for the common developmental issues seen in children with ASD
