


Does your child *currently* have ADHD or ADD?

In 2007, 7.2% of US children and 9.1% of children in Maryland had *current* ADHD, by parent report.

In 2011, 8.8% of US children and 8.9% of children in Maryland had *current* ADHD, by parent report.





Among all US states, Maryland ranked 12th highest.

Among all US states, Maryland ranked 30th highest.

Is your child <u>currently</u> taking medication for ADHD or ADD? In 2007, 4.8% of US children and 6.1% of children in Maryland were taking medication for ADHD.




In 2011, 6.1% of US children and 5.8% of children in Maryland were taking medication for ADHD.
