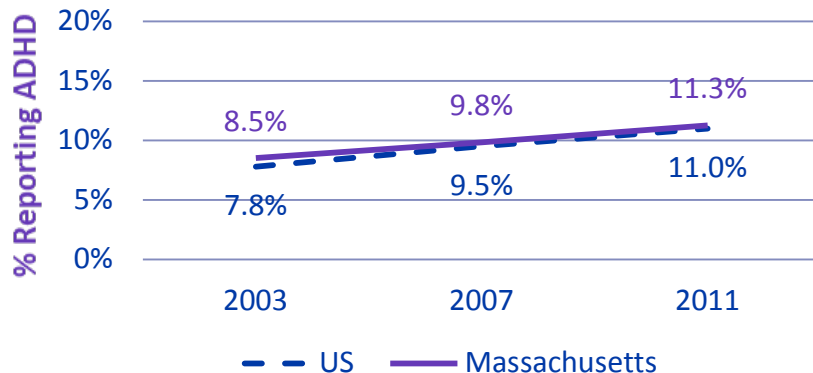

Survey Question

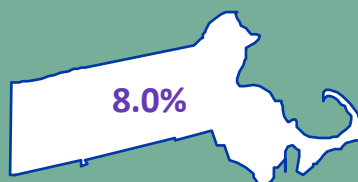
Has a doctor or health care provider **ever** told you that your child had attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder or attention deficit disorder (**ADHD or ADD**)?



Does your child **currently** have ADHD or ADD?

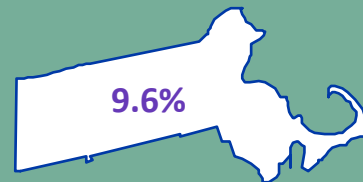
In 2007, 7.2% of US children and 8.0% of children in Massachusetts had **current** ADHD, by parent report.

In 2011, 8.8% of US children and 9.6% of children in Massachusetts had **current** ADHD, by parent report.

Among all US states, Massachusetts ranked 19th highest.



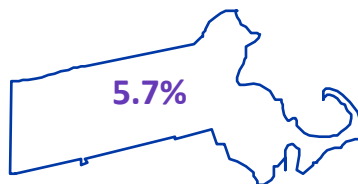
2011

Is your child **currently** taking medication for ADHD or ADD?

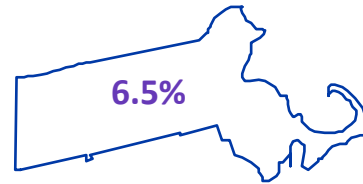
In 2007, 4.8% of US children and 5.7% of children in Massachusetts were taking medication for ADHD

In 2011, 6.1% of US children and 6.5% of children in Massachusetts were taking medication for ADHD.
