


State Profile: Vermont

Survey Question


Has a doctor or health care provider ***ever*** told you that your child had attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder or attention deficit disorder (**ADHD or ADD**)?



Does your child ***currently*** have ADHD or ADD?


In 2007, 7.2% of US children and 7.8% of children in Vermont had ***current*** ADHD, by parent report.

In 2011, 8.8% of US children and 9.4% of children in Vermont had ***current*** ADHD, by parent report.

Among all US states, Vermont ranked 21st highest.




2011

Is your child ***currently*** taking medication for ADHD or ADD?


In 2007, 4.8% of US children and 4.2% of children in Vermont were taking medication for ADHD.

In 2011, 6.1% of US children and 6.6% of children in Vermont were taking medication for ADHD.
