


# State Profile: Wisconsin

## Parent-Reported Diagnosis of ADHD by a Health Care Provider and Medication Treatment Among Children 4-17 Years: National Survey of Children's Health\* – 2003 to 2011


### Survey Question

Has a doctor or health care provider ***ever*** told you that your child had attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder or attention deficit disorder (**ADHD or ADD**)?




Does your child ***currently*** have ADHD or ADD?

In 2007, 7.2% of US children and 7.6% of children in Wisconsin had ***current*** ADHD, by parent report.



Among all US states, Wisconsin ranked 22<sup>nd</sup> highest.


In 2011, 8.8% of US children and 10.4% of children in Wisconsin had ***current*** ADHD, by parent report.



Among all US states, Wisconsin ranked 15<sup>th</sup> highest.


Is your child ***currently*** taking medication for ADHD or ADD?

In 2007, 4.8% of US children and 5.8% of children in Wisconsin were taking medication for ADHD.



Among all US states, Wisconsin ranked 16<sup>th</sup> highest.

In 2011, 6.1% of US children and 8.0% of children in Wisconsin were taking medication for ADHD.



Among all US states, Wisconsin ranked 10<sup>th</sup> highest.
