Applying Filters

Example screen from Community Counts data visualization tool.

You can apply filters from the form fields near the top of the page.

In this example, we will look at male, patients, of all races, ethnicities, and ages.

In the filter dropdown for Demographics under sex, select male.

Click the Apply button to apply filters. Be sure to do this every time you select filters.

Let's only include diagnosis of Hemophilia A and B.

Under the with field option select Hemophilia A and Hemophilia B check boxes.

Click the Apply button to apply the filter.

Finally, let's add another filter that only includes patients with private insurance.

Under the and filter dropdown, under insurance type select the Private checkbox.

Don't forget to click the Apply button.

The status bar at the top and thumbnails have been updated to reflect our selected filters.

Let's explore one of the updated visuals. Click the view button below the visual thumbnail.

As shown here, categories with 5 or fewer patients will be suppressed.

Click Clear Filters button to clear all filters.
