The US Department of Health and Human Services continues its long-standing dedication to improving the health and wellness of all Americans. Administered and supported by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the PICH program enables awardees to implement community-level interventions that reduce chronic diseases where people live, work, and play.

In FY 2014, PICH funded \$49.3 million to 39 awardees that represent governmental agencies and nongovernmental organizations, including school districts, local governments, hospital and health systems, community-based organizations, public health offices, and American Indian Tribes/ Tribal Organizations.
