- Unofficial or official school transcript from undergraduate degree **AND** current graduate school studies
- 2 letters of recommendation (1 must be from a current graduate school faculty member)
- 2 Essay questions (both are required):
 - Essay question 1: Please describe your interest in the environment, in health, and describe your interest in the intersection between the two. (1000 words max)
 - Essay question 2: What makes you a strong candidate for this program? Please include academics, extracurricular activities, previous related jobs or internships, and travel experiences.

Submit all application materials via e-mail, fax, or U.S. mail.
