



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
## Problem

## Measurable and meaningful indicators for evaluation

- Objective: Increased Information Sharing  
 Activity: Sharing of Lead Certification Status of all MF Housing Property  
 Indicator: CEH's receipt of a quarterly updated list of MF properties that includes:
- ✓ All MF Properties
  - ✓ All properties that are exempt from Lead Certification
  - ✓ The lead status of non-exempt properties

## Measurable and meaningful indicators for evaluation

- Objective: Increased Information Sharing  
 Activity: Sharing of property data that could (have) poison(ed) a child  
 Indicator: MF receipt of quarterly updates from CEH of properties that have been identified as non certified and that could have poisoned or have poisoned a child
