The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) agree to extend the duration of the *Memorandum of Understanding between the National Aeronautics and Space Administration Office of Earth Science, Applications Division [now the NASA Science Mission Directorate, Earth Science Division, Applied Sciences Program] and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention National Center for Environmental Health/Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry*, signed February 5, 2004, for five (5) additional years, thus extending the expiration date of the Agreement until February 5, 2014.


