National Center for Environmental Health/Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry


The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) agree to extend the duration of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, Science Mission Directorate, Earth Science Division, Applied Science Program and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, National center for Environmental Health/Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry, signed February 4, 2004, for five (5) additional years, thus extending the expiration date of the MOU until February 5, 2019.

Additional changes under this amendment are provided as follows:

- 1) Part IV. A. 5, "Establish an interagency working group to accelerate the development, evaluation, and utilization of Earth system science, technology, and data for environmental public health" shall be deleted in its entirety.
- 2) The CDC and ATSDR Responsible Officers are replaced with:
